## ***Aid and Attendance***

### 2023 MONTHLY AMOUNTS

- ✦ MARRIED VETERAN - \$2642
- ✦ SINGLE VETERAN - \$2229

- ✦ SPOUSE OF A LIVING VETERAN - \$1750

*Veterans and their surviving spouses can be eligible for money to help pay for their care.*

## ***Qualifications***

### SERVICE

90 days of active service  
One day during a period of war  
Active combat not required

### NEED FOR AID

Living in an Assisted Living  
Or Nursing Home  
OR Receiving Home Care  
OR Getting help from a friend or family member in your home

### FINANCIAL LIMITS

If you fit the service requirements and the need for aid, income and assets should not hold you back from getting benefits, if you do the proper planning

## ***Eligible Wars***

**World War II** December 7, 1941 through December 31, 1946

**Korean Conflict** June 27, 1950 through January 31, 1955

**Vietnam Era** August 5, 1964 through May 7, 1975  
*(Veterans who served in the Republic of Vietnam between 11/1/55 - 8/4/64 are eligible)*

**American Merchant Marines** December 7, 1941 through August 15, 1945

**Gulf War** Eligibility criteria differs from prior wartime periods, contact the VA for eligibility.
